Yours, as one of the Elgin area's leading restaurants; ours, as organizations committed to addressing the alarming increase in hunger throughout this area and to whom so many local families and individuals living on the hard edge of poverty look for sustenance.

We are proposing an alliance and invite you to be part of it: **on Saturday, November 13—at the SPJST Lodge , 702 Highway 95 S, Elgin, TX 78621—from 11 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.**, local chefs will be joining forces to produce **Elgin's 4th "Empty Bowl Project"**. As part of a national campaign to combat hunger and its root causes, these events showcase the culinary talents of local restaurants and raise both awareness of hunger and funds enabling local food pantries to serve the needy.

The Elgin event teams the countywide initiative (the Bastrop County Emergency Food Pantry and Support Center) with two local complementing efforts (the First Baptist Church of Elgin and the Elgin Community Cupboard). All three are all experiencing increasing demand for services overall; and all are seeing an increasing number of first-time Elgin clients. This growing demand severely strains our limited resources and leads us to seek further community support. A portion of profits will be shared with local pantries.

We invite you to add your talents to the mix...by presenting and serving **10-15 gallons** of a soup, stew or chili of your creation to the 200 expected attendees. In addition to the broad recognition the event brings to participating providers, a panel of judges will bestow bragging rights for "bests" in five categories: 1) cream based soup, 2) broth based soup, 3) chili, 4) stew and 5) table presentation. Attendees will also have their say by voting for their "Fan Favorite" from among all providers. Winners and runners-up will be announced before 1 p.m., and we will follow up with local print and social media afterwards.

A representative of the event organizing committee will be contacting you to talk about your participation in the event. Meanwhile, we have enclosed details of the event and a form to confirm your participation.

Event details for participating restaurants:

- **Event set-up:** Please arrive at the SPJST, [702 Highway 95 S, Elgin, TX 78621](#) on Saturday, November 13 between 9:30-10 a.m. (**but no later than 10 a.m.**) for set up.

You may unload in front of the main area near the building; parking is available back of the parking lot. Volunteers will assist with unloading. All soups must be ready for judging at **10:20 a.m. and for public service by 11 a.m.**

If you need the Pantry to assign volunteers to serve your soup, please contact us immediately at 512-303-0033.

- Feel free to bring your menus, business cards, and promotional coupons and to decorate your table space. No “off-table” decorations please! (**There will be a “Best Table Presentation” award!**)
- Each provider will be assigned a **6-foot table**, draped with a **black floor length table covering**. Table assignments will be based upon power requirement as specified on the confirmation form you submit.

Electrical service for high wattage appliances is very limited; please consider using chafing dishes. If you will use an electrical heating appliance, please bring an extension cord rated for your appliance and please advise us by **NOVEMBER 1st of the electrical requirements of your appliance.**

- Volunteers will be available to direct you to your assigned table. **The Pantry will provide an initial supply of disposable 6 oz. bowls, spoons and napkins** (and will replenish supplies as needed during the event).
- **Soups on!** Doors open to the public promptly at 11 a.m.; the event ends at 1:30 p.m. Judges’ awards and the “Fan Favorite” award will be announced before 1 p.m. All award winners will be publicized in local media and by social media after the event.
